

FLORAL FIESTA DISHWARE CHIP N DIP BOWL



MATERIALS

CCX004 Chip-n-Dip Bowl Liner Brush Small Brush Detail Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker NCR Flower Pattern Red Pen

COLORS

CMM 90 - Red Hot Boat CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up CMM 48 - Guacamole CMM 59 - Turquoise CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon

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INSTRUCTIONS

The Floral Fiesta Set is meant to be imperfect. From the flowers and dots, to the imperfect color, this is meant to look whimsical and handmade. Make this set your own; sketch on the flowers free hand, change up the colors. If you feel better with a pattern, there is one attached.

- Use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers. These are supposed to be imperfect and all slightly different. If you prefer, there is a pattern below. Use NCR paper to trace the flowers by pressing firmly with a pen as you trace over the design.
- 2. To begin, trace one flower about an inch from the outside rim.
- 3. Move about 3" down from the first flower and sketch on another one. Continue adding a flower every 3" or so until you work your way back to the first flower. We ended up with 6 flowers.
- 4. Next, sketch a flower between two of the first flowers. This time the flower should be toward the inner rim of the plate. Repeat this step working your way around the plate.
- 5. Next, sketch a long branch of leaves between the outer flowers. Then a short brand of leaves between the inner flowers.
- 6. Apply 2 coats of Turquoise to each flower using a detail brush.
- 7. Next, fill in the leaves with 2 coats of Guacamole using a liner brush.
- 8. Use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch a line that falls 1/2" down from the outside edge and then another line that is 1/2" down from the inside rim.
- 9. Paint the background of the outer section of the plate with 2 coats of Red Hot, painting around the flowers and leaves, between the two pencil lines.
- 10. Dip the end of a detail brush into Sunny Side Up paint. Tap a row of dots just above the outer edge of the red paint going around the entire plate.
- 11. Next, dip the end of a detail brush into Guacamole paint. Tap a row of dots just above the inner edge of the red paint going all the way around.
- 12. Load up a small brush with Blue Lagoon paint. Press in the center of each flower with one generous coat.
- 13. Dip the handle of the detail brush into Pumpkin Pie paint. Apply a ring of small dots around the blue center of the flowers.

14. Sketch a flower in the middle of the inner section.

15. Then, sketch a line about 1/2" down from the rim, and then another line about 1/2" down from the first one.

16. Use a liner brush to paint three coats of Pumpkin Pie on the flower in the center of the dish.

17. Paint around the flower with 2 coats of Blue Lagoon, all the way up to the lower pencil line.

18. Next, paint the band between the two pencil lines with 2 coats of Sunny Side Up.

19. Dip the tip of a detail brush into Pumpkin Pie paint. Tap a row of dots above the yellow band.


20. Dip the handle end of the detail brush into Red Hot paint. Tap a cluster of small dots to the inside of the orange flower.

TIPS

- Remember this is supposed to be funky and hand-painted, don't stress for perfection. It's better if it's more loose.
- When making the dots on the border, we used the tip of the paintbrush to get a more imperfect dot. You could also use the handle end of a paintbrush dipped into paint to apply the dots. This will give a more uniform dot.
- We intentionally did only 2 coats of paint to make the color uneven, highlighting the handpainted aspect. If you prefer, you could do 3 coats of a more solid color.

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
