


SEASONAL PRINTS SWEETHEART PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

C06480 Heart Plate Medium Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker Writing Bottle Yellow Sponge Quarter

COLORS

CMM 90- Red Hot CMM 7 - Blush CMM 31 - Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors or number of prints. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Starting with the larger feet first, use a medium brush to apply a generous coat of Blush to the left foot.
- 2. Place the foot on the lower left side of the plate and press firmly.
- 3. Repeat steps 1–2, this time using the right foot and placing it on the lower right side with the heels touching to create a heart shape. Allow the prints to dry.
- 4. For the smaller feet, use a medium brush to apply a generous coat of Red Hot to the left foot.
- 5. Place the foot on the middle left side of the plate and press firmly.
- 6. Repeat steps 1–2, this time using the right foot and placing it on the middle right side with the heels touching to create a heart shape.
- 7. Sketch the words with a pencil or a water-based marker.
- 8. Use a writer bottle with Licorice paint to apply the words and names.

TIPS

- When sketching in pencil for the writing, gently rub back and forth over the pencil lines to remove excess graphite. This will make it easier to write on top of it.
- For the writing bottle, only fill the bottle 1/2 way to avoid it coming out too fast. This will help with smaller writing.
- Get the writer bottle flowing on a paper towel before you write on your piece. This will work out any air and sputtering that might occur.
- ** These samples don't have a year painted on them, we suggest putting the year somewhere on the plate.
