


BOLD SARDINES ANCHOVIES APP PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB37469 Squrve Dessert Plate

Medium Brush

Detail Brush

Liner Brush

NCR Patterns

Red Ballpoint Pen

Pencil or Waterbased Marker

Scissors

COLORS

CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie
CMM 7 - Blush
CMM 22 - Gecko Green
CMM 90 - Red Hot
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon
CMM 43 - Saffire



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use scissors to cut the NCR paper pattern down so it's easier to transfer onto the piece.
- 2. Place the NCR paper pattern on top of the plate and firmly trace over the lines using a ballpoint pen. You don't need to trace the letters now; we will trace them later.
- 3. Use a liner brush to apply a thin line of Banana Boat to the edge of the tin. If helpful, use the photo as a reference.
- 4. Use a liner brush to fill in the fish with three coats of paint:
 - a. Top of the fish Banana Boat
 - b. Bottom of the fish Gecko Green
 - c. Face of the fish Pumpkin Pie.
- 5. Paint the tin lid (painting around the oval in the center) with three generous coats of Pumpkin Pie.
- 6. Fill in the fish in the center of the oval with three coats of Gecko Green.
- 7. Using the photo as a guide, use a liner brush to apply three generous coats of Red Hot to the bottom section of the tin.
- 8. Fill in the roll in the lid with three generous coats of Blush.
- 9. Paint the space around the fish with three generous coats of Saffire.
- 10. Use a liner brush to apply the red details: the line around the oval, the scales on all of the fish, the mouths on all of the fish, and the spiral on the bottom of the rolled lid.
- 11. When the top of the plate is dry, use the NCR pattern to trace on the lettering. Use a detail brush to apply the letters using Saffire paint.
- 12. Next, use the liner brush again to apply a thin line of Blue Lagoon on the orange lid as well as the eye and line on the fish in the oval.
- 13. Finally, dip the handle of the detail brush into Snowflake and tap a dot on each fish for the eye. The dip the handle into Deep Sea and put a smaller dot inside each white dot.

TIPS

- Apply three generous coats of paint in order to get solid colors.
- When using the liner brush, you can thin down the paint slightly to help the lines flow more easily.
